STAYS, RECALLS, & DISTRACTIONS OUTSIDE

This is a class for the dog who knows the basics but has a bit of difficulty responding to commands when there are other animals, other people or any other distractions present. In this class we work on leash walking with distractions, recalls with more distractions and distance, and stays with more duration and increased distractions.

PUPPY KINDERGARTEN – A.K.C. S.T.A.R. Puppy

Start off on the right foot with puppy training class to teach appropriate behavior to your puppy and build a strong foundation for obedience. Our puppy training classes provide education on topics such as leadership, manners, and socialization, while also addressing the common puppy behaviors such as puppy biting, destructive chewing, barking and house training. Included in this puppy training program are puppy gentling exercises and the basic obedience exercises.

A.K.C. GOOD CITIZEN ADVANCED

A.K.C. Community Canine expands on CGC skills and lays the beginning foundation for obedience, rally and therapy dog work. While Canine Good Citizen tests are simulations of real world skills, the goal of A.K.C. Community Canine is to test the dog's abilities in a natural setting. Rather than the test being administered in a ring, certain elements will involve the dog walking through a real crowd, whether at a dog show or on a busy sidewalk. Eligible dogs for the A.K.C. Community Canine title must have a CGC certificate.
