FAMILY DOG BASIC OBEDIENCE

Obedience training is the foundation of good behavior. Whether you want a well-behaved family pet or a dog that will go on to competition or field training. Our training sessions are designed to be fun, informative and a sure method to establish a permanent bond between you and your dog. Classes are an excellent means of stimulating your dog's intelligence and training his or her mind with positive reinforcement. This class is for dogs 5 months and older. Your dog will learn sit, heel, stay, come on command and the always important "no".

STAYS, RECALLS, & DISTRACTIONS OUTSIDE

This is a class for the dog who knows the basics but has a bit of difficulty responding to commands when there are other animals, other people or any other distractions present. In this class we work on leash walking with distractions, recalls with more distractions and distance, and stays with more duration and increased distractions.

Session 1 is OUTSIDE: Saturday, May 1st and is every Saturday from 11:30 – 12:30pm (No class on 5/29) with Paula Cortiana

Session 2 is OUTSIDE: Thursday, May 6th and is every Thursday from 7:00 – 8:00pm with Paula Cortiana

PUPPY KINDERGARTEN – A.K.C. S.T.A.R. Puppy

Start off on the right foot with puppy training class to teach appropriate behavior to your puppy and build a strong foundation for obedience. Our puppy training classes provide education on topics such as leadership, manners, and socialization, while also addressing the common puppy behaviors such as puppy biting, destructive chewing, barking and house training. Included in this puppy training program are puppy gentling exercises and the basic obedience exercises.

A.K.C. GOOD CITIZEN ADVANCED

A.K.C. Community Canine expands on CGC skills and lays the beginning foundation for obedience, rally and therapy dog work. While Canine Good Citizen tests are simulations of real world skills, the goal of A.K.C. Community Canine is to test the dog's abilities in a natural setting. Rather than the test being administered in a ring, certain elements will involve the dog walking through a real crowd, whether at a dog show or on a busy sidewalk. Eligible dogs for the A.K.C. Community Canine title must have a CGC certificate.
